## Ms. May - Grades 1st - 4th <br> May 6 - May 10

Music and Motion: 1st and 2nd Grade
This week is all about practicing our Do Re Mi harmony parts. All kids will be learning both parts and 'trading' them back and forth during the song, so we'll be having lots of fun with focus and concentration.
Ukulele 1 (Beginners): 3 rd and 4th grade We will be reviewing how chord spelling helps us begin to understand how harmony works and why certain notes sound good with certain chords. We will break down the chords for Million Dreams into their individual notes and assess how these chords support the melody.
We will continue with our harmony part to the Flower Drum Song, and chord work with Million Dreams and A Sky Full of Stars.
Ukulele 2 (Intermediate): 3rd and 4th grade This class is going all out with skill building on Million Dreams. Fingerpicking, bar chords, and working on three different strum patterns. We will also go over their rhythm key, focusing on 16th notes and dotted 8th notes. This will help them continue their work on the Flower Drum Song.
Those who are looking for a challenge are working even more on bar chords and fast chord switching for Happy.
